Council Chairman Vincent C. Gray announces a public hearing by the Committee of the Whole on Bill 18-873, the "Closing and Dedication of Portions of a Public Alley in Square 5260, S.O. 10-13494, Act of 2010." The public hearing is scheduled for Friday, October 22, 2010, at 2:00 p.m., in Room 500 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW. Bill 18-873, introduced by Councilmember Alexander, would close portion of the public alley system and the dedication of a new portion of the alley system in Square 5260 bounded by Eastern Avenue, N.E., 61st Street, N.E., and Dix Street, N.E., in Ward 7. The applicant, Dix Street Corridor Revitalization Partners, LLC, seek this alley realignment to facilitate the development of new affordable housing townhomes.
